Consider and act on a resolution of the City Council of the City of Celina, Texas finding that a public necessity exists and authorizing condemnation to acquire rights of way totaling 1.061 acres and a temporary construction easements of 1.052 acres for municipal purposes to build and maintain a public roadway, including but not limited to, grading, such appurtenant facilities as may be necessary, and other public uses, on two real properties as portions of tracts of land generally described as being located in the Shelby Glass Survey, Abstract A0346, Property ID #2848008 and #2802386, and on real property as portion of a tract of land generally described as being located in the Jonathan Westover Survey, Abstract A1030, Property ID # 2706744, Collin County, Texas; such properties are generally located on the north and south sides of Choate Parkway east of Kinship Parkway, and being more particularly described herein; providing notice of an official determination to acquire real properties for rights of way and temporary construction easements, such appurtenant facilities as may be necessary, and other public uses; authorizing the city manager to obtain the necessary appraisal reports and make bona fide offers of just compensation for the rights of way and easements; ratifying prior documents made for acquisition of the rights of way and easements; authorizing legal counsel to institute eminent domain proceedings on behalf of the city for the acquisition of the rights of way and easements on said tracts if negotiations are unsuccessful; appropriating funds from a lawful source; providing a cumulative repealer clause; providing a severability clause and providing for an effective date.

Upon a motion Council Member Cawfield moved and Council Member Wigginton seconded that the City Council of the City of Celina adopt Resolution No. 2024-39R and authorize the use of the power of eminent domain to acquire rights of way totaling 1.061 acres and temporary construction easements totaling 1.052 acres on two tracts of land located in the Shelby Glass Survey, Abstract A0346, Property ID's #2848008 and #2802386, and on a tract of land located in the Jonathan Westover Survey, Abstract A1030, Property ID #2706744, Collin County, Texas, such properties are generally located on the north and south sides of Choate Parkway east of Kinship Parkway (as more fully described and depicted in Exhibits "A" and "B" of the proposed resolution for this item) for a public purpose and use to install and maintain public utilities, including but not limited to, the municipal purpose of the installation and maintenance of a future roadway, grading, such appurtenant facilities as may be necessary, and other public uses, with this motion and the first record vote applying to all units of property to be condemned. The results of the Roll Call Vote on Resolution No. 2024-39R were: Council Member Cawfield in favor, Council Member Ferguson in favor, Council Member Grumbles in favor, Mayor Pro Tem Hopkins in favor, Deputy Mayor Pro Tem Koehne in favor, Council Member Wigginton in favor. Motion to approve Resolution No. 2024-39R passed 6 to 0.

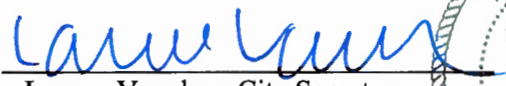
