IV. **WORKSESSION:**

A. Discussion of an art event. (Kearney & Tucker)

Brad Kearney, Director of Strategic Services, and Stephanie Tucker, EDC Special Projects Manager, presented regarding an art event in Downtown Celina. The Arts and Culture Board discussed focusing the event on artists who are 18 years old or more to cultivate an arts community in Celina.

B. Discussion of Downtown Center exterior murals. (Kearney)

Brad Kearney, Director of Strategic Services, provided an update to the Board regarding the selection of a finalist for the exterior murals on the Downtown Center.

C. Discussion of Fire Station #4 mural project. (Kearney)

Brad Kearney, Director of Strategic Services, provided an update to the Board regarding the process to select an artist for the Fire Station #4 mural. The Board recommended artists to invite to submit a concept for the project.

D. Discussion of parks administration building mural project. (Kearney)

Brad Kearney, Director of Strategic Services, provided an update to the Board regarding delaying the schedule to select an artist for a mural on the exterior of the parks administration building. The Board recommended waiting until 2027 to begin the project.

E. Discussion of arts and culture master plan and update process. (Kearney)

Brad Kearney, Director of Strategic Services, presented to the Board regarding City Council's intention to update the Arts and Culture Master Plan without using a consultant. The Board discussed reviewing the master plan prior to the next meeting to prepare for an in depth discussion of changes to the master plan.
