RESOLUTION NO. 2020-18R

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CELINA, TEXAS RATIFYING A SECOND MAYORAL DECLARATION OF LOCAL STATE OF DISASTER DUE TO PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY AND CONSENTING TO ITS CONTINUATION FOR MORE THAN SEVEN DAYS; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Celina is a Home Rule Municipality located in Collin County and Denton County, Texas, created in accordance with the provisions of the Texas Local Government Code and operating pursuant to the enabling legislation of the State of Texas and the Constitution of the State of Texas; and

WHEREAS, on March 24, 2020, Mayor Sean Terry, acting in accordance with authority granted to him under the City Charter and under Section 418.108 of the Texas Government Code, declared a Second Mayoral Declaration of Local State of Disaster Due to Public Health Emergency (the “disaster declaration”); and

WHEREAS, Section 418.108(b) of the Texas Government Code provides that such a disaster declaration may not be continued for a period of more than seven days except with the consent of the governing body of the political subdivision; and

WHEREAS, the City Council supports the disaster declaration signed by Mayor Sean Terry on March 24, 2020, and consents to its continuation for a period of more than seven days.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CELINA, TEXAS:

- Section 1:** That the City Council hereby ratifies the disaster declaration signed by Mayor Sean Terry on March 24, 2020, and consents to its continuation for a period of more than seven days and such disaster declaration is hereby continued until such time as it is terminated by order of the City Council; and
- Section 2.** That this disaster declaration, ratification and continuation shall be filed with the City Secretary and given prompt and general publicity pursuant to Section 418(d) of the Texas Government Code and published on the City website at www.celina-tx.gov; and
- Section 3.** That the City’s Emergency Management Plan shall be implemented and continued to be executed; and
- Section 4.** That this disaster declaration, ratification and continuation authorizes the City to take any actions pursuant to Chapter 418 of the Texas Government Code and Chapter 122 of the Texas Health and Safety Code
